### HOW TO USE

- Fill the reservoir in the dispenser with liquid hand soap.
- Pressing the button on the dispenser releases a small amount into the palm of the hand.
- Add a little warm water and build up a lather to lift dirt and soils. Rinse with warm water.
- Always dry hands thoroughly after use. Always wash hands following handling raw food, refuse or visiting the toilet.
- Ensure you wet your hands first then apply the soap. Clean in between your fingers and finger nails properly.

- Rinse off all the soap with clean water and dry with a paper towel.
- Soap residues on skin may cause irritation with prolonged contact.

#### **Keep Dispensers Hygienically Clean:**

As a frequently touched piece of equipment, care should be taken to ensure that the soap dispensers are kept hygienically clean and that residues of soap are periodically wiped from surrounds of the dispenser and the vending nozzle.
